

2010 Lottery Results Almanac Published

Latest edition of highly-regarded annual lottery reference book

MARTINSVILLE, N.J. (January 31, 2011)—The latest edition of Lottery Post's highly-regarded lottery results reference book officially went on sale today.

Lottery Post 2010 Lottery Results Almanac, United States Edition (ISBN 978-0-9826272-2-8), written by the creator of the popular Lottery Post web site and published by Speednet Group, is available for purchase immediately online at the publisher's web site (<http://books.speednet.biz>). The title also will be available at major online retailers such as Amazon.com, Baker & Taylor, and Barnes & Noble, and book stores can stock the book through wholesale book distributor Ingram.

Last year's 2009 edition of the almanac garnered 5-star reviews at Amazon.com, as lottery players added the unique and valuable reference book to their bookshelves. Lottery fans cheered the definitive source of nationwide lottery results that was lacking in the lottery industry for many years, as well as the ability to obtain the data in well-organized hard copy book form.

"Lottery players are bombarded with hundreds of 'get rich quick' books containing lottery systems, wheels, and advice, but there are very few books available containing factual data on which to base all those systems," said Todd Northrop, the book's author and creator of Lottery Post. "Part of the reason is because it can be so difficult for an author to pull that kind of data together and to organize it all into book form."

"Since Lottery Post already maintains one of the most comprehensive and accurate lottery results databases available," Northrop continued, "I was able to leverage that valuable asset and focus on editorial efforts — making a mountain of data highly readable and referenceable."

The Lottery Post 2010 Lottery Results Almanac, United States Edition covers the winning numbers for all United States lottery games in the year 2010. Puerto Rico lottery results are also included. In addition to the winning numbers, each game is described, including drawing schedule, game number matrix, drawing method, online links, and other pertinent notes.

The annual Canada edition of the book is planned for publication in February.
